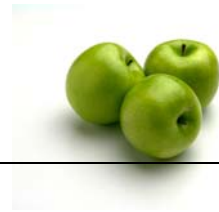

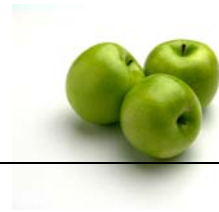

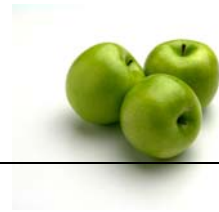
Who Should Use This Directory

The ADAF Directory of Resources for International Food, Nutrition, and Dietetic Professionals is designed for use by practitioners, graduates with Baccalaureate (or equivalent), or Graduate degrees in nutrition (biomedical), food, dietetics, public health, agriculture, foodservice management, food science, food science technology, and related areas. Individuals pursuing a professional degree may use this directory, or professionals who are seeking continuing education, training or work experience nationally or internationally. Contact information and general guidelines for numerous organizations that offer financial assistance for studies in the United States and other countries is provided.

How to Use the Directory

The ADAF Directory of Resources for International Food, Nutrition, and Dietetic Professionals was created to simplify the process of seeking financial assistance for international students and professionals by organizing food, nutrition, dietetics and other related resources and contact information in one source. This Directory is divided into six sections. The first section lists those organizations that provide resources to American students and professionals.
