2 FUNDRAISING

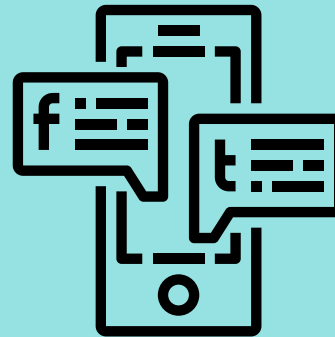
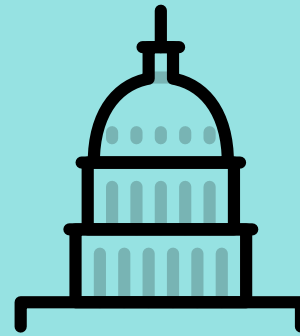
Explore opportunities for fundraising to boost efforts at the state and national level.
